5. **A sound system** such as an old-fashioned AM/FM radio, satellite radio or a CB radio. (Helmet speakers are also available—just make sure they're legal in your state before you invest in them.)

6. **Custom light** options include strip lights that make your bike more visible, pencil beam driving lamps that project far into the distance or wide beams.

7. **A windshield** can help you stay warm during chilly nights and keep bugs out of your face.

8. **A fresh paint job** in a monotone color or one with a funky design—whatever screams you.

9. **A touch of chrome** is always popular and can be added to almost any part of your bike.

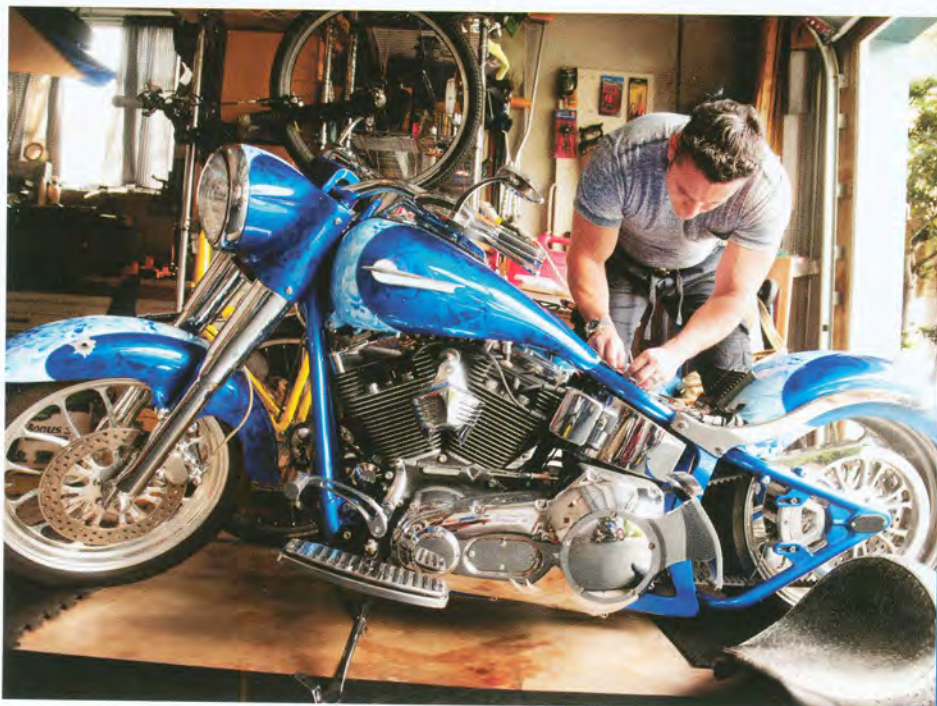
10. **A new set of wheels** can add style but and generally most riders opt for wider ones.

11. **Change up the shocks** to customize how stiff (or how soft) your ride is.

12. **New foot pegs** such as highway pegs or forward-facing pegs are good for those longer road trips.
