## **Public Health**

A gas-powered leaf blower with a two-stroke engine can emit as much gaseous fumes in one hour as a car drive for 1100 miles.

#### Wildlife

# **Worker Safety**

The use of gas-powered leaf blowers poses serious risks for lawn care company employees, who are constantly exposed to toxic fumes and dangerous noise levels.

#### **Mental Health**

Noise degrades quality of life and creates levels of frustration and aggravation that last even when the noise has ceased.

### What Can You Do?

- -Use a cordless electric leaf blower or a rake. If economic do not permit a purchase, considering talking to your neighbors about buying one to share.
